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
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
IRWM Plan Development Schedule



Survey on Objectives and Climate Change Vulnerabilities

Online Survey of Region's Stakeholders

- Sent in September to all Stakeholders who have attended an SAC meeting
- Based on <u>IRWM Plan Objectives</u> identified by SAC in August and <u>Climate Change</u> <u>Vulnerabilities</u> identified by SAC in September
- Asked to mark the 3-5 highest priorities for each

Prioritization of Vulnerabilities and Objectives

Decision by RWMG Based on SAC Feedback

- <u>IRWM Plan Objectives</u>: All Objectives would are priority for the Region, with no numerical priority. Objects relate to water supply are of immediate interest.
- <u>Climate Change Vulnerabilities</u>: All considered a priority but the top four identified in survey were assigned as a higher priority level



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
